Dear Joe,

The following are the meeting notes for the Kitchen at SAD # 46, Dexter School. I met with Nancy Price the Foodservice Director, we talked about her needs and concerns. We review a plan from another school that has similar features as this project.

1. Dry Storage needs to be approximately 300 sq/ft.
2. Both the Walk-In Cooler and Freezer need to be a minimum of 150 sq/ft. each.
3. There will be a common dishroom with two pass-thru windows serving the two dinning areas.
4. Conveyor Style Dishwasher
5. ScrapMaster type Scrapping Sink with Trough.
6. An Office for two people is required.
7. Employee Toilet.
8. Employee Lockers
9. Employee Break Room if possible.
10. Elementary School Serving Line
 - a. Milk Dispenser
 - b. Hot Food Wells (4)
 - c. Flat Top Counters
 - d. Salad Bar (4 wells) Along partition wall.
 - e. Cashier Counter. Along partition wall.
11. Middle School Serving Counter
 - a. Milk/Juice Dispenser
 - b. Hot Food Wells (4)
 - c. Cold Sandwiches
 - d. Hot Sandwiches
 - e. Pizza
 - f. Salad Bar (5 wells) Dual Sided, In dinning space.
 - g. Cashier Counter, Dual Sided, In Dinning space.
12. Separate Ala-Carte Serving Line in Cafeteria.
13. Pass-thru Heated Cabinets and Refrigerators at Middle School Serving Counter.
14. Walls between serving areas and kitchen.
15. Full width rolling doors at serving counters.
16. 6 or 7 work/prep stations
17. Full Baking Prep Area.
